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Follow the Northern Lights Tour Sep – Oct 2007

We are well underway with the planning this trip but we already have strong interest from about 13-17 people and there is no doubt it will definitely go ahead.

This will be a stunning and unique tour. After months researching the situation we are convinced there is nothing like it literally any where in the world. Whilst there are many companies that offer sections of the tour, there appears to be no other package that links all the elements together.

We are in the process of creating a tour that is truly spectacular and original. At present the outline looks roughly like the following:



The Dates.

The central components of the tour will occur during September – October 2007. The precise dates for each person will be depend on whether participants elect to undertake the whole tour or only the core element.

The Modular Design of the Tour.

The tour will be modular in design. This will mean that people who do not have the time or money to complete the entire program can finish their participation at various transit points on the itinerary. For instance, some people may leave the tour in St. Johns, Newfoundland. Others might leave after Niagara Falls or the Hudson Bay whilst yet others might elect to do the complete trip.

The Basic Itinerary.

Participants can fly from Australia via Asia to Europe on a Round The World airfare at a time of their choosing. They may then undertake whatever travels they want around Europe before meeting the group in Copenhagen at a pre-arranged date. At this



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stage we think the meeting date will be 30th August 2007.

The group will fly from there to Iceland on 1st September and spend the next 10 days exploring the tourist icons of spectacular Iceland. The itinerary takes in glaciers, thermal pools, thundering waterfalls, fertile valleys and barren plains.

On 11th September we will start our cruise to Greenland. The details of the cruise are set out separately. It is suffice to say here that the ship will sail west across the Strait of Denmark to the south-east coast of Greenland and then down around the south coast. There will be plenty of opportunities to go ashore and study the wildlife. The ship carries a fleet of Zodiacs especially for this purpose.

On the 20th September we will depart Greenland waters & head south to Newfoundland & Nova Scotia. After cruising along these spectacular coasts with shore visits every day we disembark in St. Johns the capital of Newfoundland on 28th September.

After 4 05 5 nights in newfoundland we will fly to Quebec City for a couple of nights in this unique and beautiful city around 2nd October.



The group will fly to Toronto and stop 2 nights so that we have time to visit Niagara Falls.

About the 7th October we intend to fly to Winnipeg & board a train to Churchill. At historic Churchill on the Hudson Bay we will engage in some amazing whale watching.

At the mouth of the Churchill River Beluga whales gather in groups of 2,000 & 3,000 at this time of year. This gives the chance of some whale watching par excellence!! A tour onto the Tundra using 6-wheel drive monsters with huge wide tires that go just about anywhere will provide opportunities for a spot of Polar bear and caribou observation.

The 14th October should see the group fly to Whitehorse in the Yukon. From here we hope to cruise down the Yukon River to Dawson as the miners did many years ago. However, if this proves impractical we will use charter bus or fly. From Dawson City we will go via Fairbanks and Denali National Park to Anchorage.

About 24th October we will travel to Haines where a side trip to Glacier Bay is possible. Then the aim is to head south down the Inland Passage to Seattle.

People can fly home via Honolulu or Samoa or Auckland.



Conclusion.

As you can see, the intention is for the trip to be spectacular but with flexibility for people to pick out the “bits” they most want. Mind you, given the strength of interest we have already received, we believe it will not be hard to fill the trip. Preference for places on the tour will be given to those wanting to do the entire trip.

We have done some pretty extensive searching over the past few months and are convinced there is no trip on offer like this one – not anywhere in the world!!! The variety of scenery will be breathtaking. The diversity and density of wildlife will be outstanding. The range of cultures will be fascinating and the historical background fascinating.

Truly this is a tour not to miss!
